


We have had an exciting week starting our new English book!

Phonics

In Phonics this week, we have been learning the alternative spellings for /ar/ and /s/.

The alternative spellings for /ar/ are: 'ar' (farm), 'al' (calm), 'a' (rather).



The alternative spellings for /s/ are: 's' (sister), 'ss' (hiss), 'sc' (scissors), 'c' (cell).

Homework

Please cut the pictures and words out, match them and stick them into your book.

Optional homework:

Play the 'snakes and ladders' game stuck into your books. This contains many of the Phase 5 graphemes and other graphemes the children have been finding tricky.

Maths

This week we have been learning about multiplication. We have been using our times tables knowledge (2, 5 and 10 time tables) to help us. We have also been drawing arrays to help us visualise a multiplication question. For example: $5 \times 2 = ?$



There is a multiplication activity assigned on Mathletics for the children to access.

English

This week we have started our new English text 'The Naughty Bus' by Jan Oke. We have read the first few pages and have been discussing the importance of school rules! We have also been writing letters to the Naughty bus to explain what our school rules are and why they are important.
