

Phonics

In Phonics this week, we have been continuing our revision of the alternative spellings for /or/.



'or' (*born*), 'aw' (*paw*), 'ore' (*shore*), 'our' (*four*), 'oor' (*door*), 'al' (*walk*) and 'augh' (*naughty*). 2 less common spellings are 'au' (*haunt*) and 'ough' (*brought*).

Homework

Play the board game, roll the dice and segment and blend each word as you land on it (each word has one of the alternative spellings for /or/ in it). Who will be the first person to the end?

Optional challenge:

Can you add sound buttons to the words on the board game?

Maths

This week we have been working on time, specifically focusing on O'clock, half past and quarter past. We have been making the time using small clocks and drawing the hands onto them, thinking about the difference between the minute hand and hour hand.

We have also been timing ourselves to perform different activities (such as 10 star jumps) using a stop watch.

English

This week we have continued our English book 'Wolves' by Emily Gravett.

We have been exploring ways of describing wolves using adjectives and have been experimenting with the different ways to portray wolves using a variety of vocabulary. We have also been collecting facts to use in our information leaflets.
