### **Homework**

For homework, I would like the children to segment and blend the words and sort them into the columns.

### Optional homework:

Play the game stuck into your books from 2 weeks ago rolling the dice and naming the graphemes as you land on them, these are graphemes we have been learning to recognise this term.

### **Maths**

This week we have been thinking about time. We have ordered the days of the week and months of the year and have been looking at our daily timetable, thinking about what times we do things. We have also been focusing on reading a clock on the hour and half past.

There is an activity assigned on Mathematics for the children to practise this.

### **English**

This week we have been creating our own stories based on our English text 'The Naughty Bus' by Jan Oke.

The last page of The Naughty Bus reads 'did I tell you, sometimes I'm the night bus too.' We have been using this to inspire our own writing. We have written the beginning, middle and end of our stories, and will write them up in neat soon!
