Phonics

In Phonics this week, we have been continuing our revision of the alternative spellings for /ee/.



'ee' (feet), 'ea' (beach), 'e' (he), 'ey' (honey), 'ie' (thief). 2 other spellings are 'e_e' (these) and 'y' (really).

We have had an extra focus on spelling all of the Phase 5 tricky words and using these words within our writing in both Phonics and English.

Homework

Read through the writing, can you spot the tricky words? The Phase 5 tricky words are: **Mr, Mrs, looked, called, asked, oh, their, could and people.** The Phase 5 'tricky word ship' on the TES website also has a brilliant game to listening and recognising these words.

Maths

This week we have been working on multiplication and division. We have been using cubes and numicon to help us solve number sentences. We have also been solving word problems which require the children to think about what the question is asking them.

Part of our learning has been based on using the correct terminology for multiplication and division.

English

This week we have started our English book 'Wolves' by Emily Gravett.

This book is partly fiction and partly non-fiction. As part of this book, we have been thinking about the difference between fiction and non-fiction and telling the difference between fact and opinion.

We are building up to writing our own information leaflets!
