Clubs for Spring Term

Please note that lunchtime clubs do not have a set limit. If your child would like to be part of a lunchtime club they can speak to the teacher directly, or you can write a note in your reading log or speak with the teacher yourself in the playground. The class teacher will then organise a list for their club which will be displayed in their classroom. We have added in one extra club which Miss Rose will be leading on a Wednesday lunchtime. There is no need for you to sign up for children as this will be a more open ended club. If your child wants to come to the library on a Wednesday they will need to fill out the form which will be posted on the Year 4 doorway each week. All the children will have systems for lunchtime clubs explained to them.

Important letters went out on Monday (and Tuesday for Football), which offered club places for Spring Term.
