English

We have learnt 'oa' (boat), 'ee' (bee) and 'oo' (boot). The class have also been working hard to recognise the Phase 2 tricky words: I, no, go, the, to, into. The children have even been trying to write them! Please continue to practise these tricky words with your child.

Maths

The children have been counting objects that are in a random order. They have been mixing objects up on a table and counting them without moving them and playing I spy. For this the children have been learning how important it is to point at the object as they count it so they don't get confused!
