SparkFish Think! Space Sessions and Y6 Transition Visit

On Tuesday 25th June, a team from Sparkfish will come to speak to our Year 6 children about transition to secondary school. SparkFish seeks to walk alongside young people, especially at times when they may be more vulnerable due to the circumstances of life. One such time is when they change schools, so we offer a programme to support transition from Year 6 to Year 7. This goes beyond practical advice, helping students to explore their feelings of gratitude and loss, fear and hope. SparkFish also offers a number of strategies to support students at times when they need extra encouragement: a friendly place to go at lunch break; a personal mentor, meeting regularly with a child or young person; and small group courses to build self-esteem or help at times of loss.

Pilgrimage

On Wednesday 23rd July, Year 6 will be going on pilgrimage with Rev Way, Mrs Cox and Mr Green. The pilgrimage will travel through the village and will give the children the opportunity to reflect on their experiences in the school over the past seven years.
