English

The children have been practising writing sentences containing a rhyming pair. They have been using pictures to help them and have worked really hard to segment and blend some trickier words. For example: g-oa-t, c-oa-t, s-t-or-k-s and f-or-k-s.

Maths

Following last week, the children have been focusing on the teen numbers, specifically identifying one more or one less than a given number. The children have been using number lines to help them. They also got to play a game on the iPads to help them consolidate this knowledge.

Phonics

The children have been consolidating their knowledge of tricky words and Phase 2 and 3 by writing simple sentences. For example: the jam is pink, and the balloon is big.

They have also started to explore two letters that make a final blend. This week they have been reading and writing words with 'lk' and 'lp' at the end.. Eg. 'milk', 'silk', 'help'.

SAL'S SHOES

Our Love Project this term is 'Sal's Shoes.' We will be collecting old shoes which need to be in good condition (no holes in the soles and clean). They also need to be age appropriate (no heels). The children have been working hard to recognise the numbers 0-20. They have been beginning to spot a missing number in a number line.

Eg:

10 11 12 ... 14 15 16

They have also been recognising them out of sequence and putting these in order. For this, the children have been using number lines and number cards.

There are number cards tucked into the homework books. Please cut these out and practise putting them in order at home.
