### English

We have continued to read 'Leon and the Place Between'. The children have worked hard this week to write their own version of the story. They have changed the character and have been working incredibly hard to describe the place between using vibrant and exciting language.

We have been using a thesaurus this week. The children have enjoyed using it to upgrade the language they use.

### Maths

The children have been consolidating their knowledge of addition this week. They have focused on using their problem solving skills to find the answer to some challenging questions and using their reasoning skills to explain their answers.

### Homework

#### Spelling

The spelling focus for this week is the '/ei/' phoneme spelt 'ei', 'eigh' and 'ey'. There is a sheet in the homework book and a spelling activity on Purple Mash.

#### Maths

There is a Maths activity set on My Maths for your child to practise their times tables. There is one set for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and one set for the 3 times tables. Your child only has to do one of these.

Continue to encourage your child to read every evening. Please write in the reading record book, or encourage the children to do this for themselves.

### Science

This term in Science, we are learning about Forces and Magnets. For this, the children have been conducting a range of experiments including investigating whether a range of objects are magnetic or not.

The children have massively enjoyed this and are beginning to understand how to use their experiment and the data it produces to form
