Love Works

Earlier in the week we were visited by Graham Humphries from 'Love Works' who spoke to all the children about the charity I mentioned in our last newsletter. The children have decided to adopt this charity as our Love Project for Spring Term. As part of this project our school will become a partner. Partners are given permission and special guidance to offer food vouchers. These vouchers can be used for any short term need. A typical food parcel can be collected from the charities centre in Merstham. If your family would like to help support the project we are asking any of you to join with us to bring in a 'tin a week'. The tin a week project allows your family to be involved in adding to the store of foods available to those having difficulties feeding their families and who live in the local area. All you have to do is bring one of the following items each week over the next few weeks up until Easter. Your family's contributions will be delivered to the Love Works Centre and will directly benefit our neighbours. Items that are really useful are tins and packets (with good best before dates) and cartons of long life milk. Please feel free to bring more than one tin or packet per week per family. Love Works has said they would love to fully restock after Christmas.
