AB thanked the group for coming and commented that it was great to have a group which covered such a broad range of stakeholders across the school community.

AB shared the criteria for the Gold Chartermark and the Charter Mark Action Plan. The group agreed the action plan was achievable and the school already had many systems in place to support the children and promote anti-bullying. AB and LB shared current practice regarding safeguarding, DSL Team, Inclusion Team, Pastoral File at Staff meetings.

2: Children's voice

The children's Anti-Bullying Partnership team joined the meeting: Lily, Seb, George, Amelie, Lucas, Maddie to introduce themselves and share some of their ideas re. raising the profile of Anti-Bullying across the school. This included age-appropriate putting information in each class to signpost children when they needed support with issues around bullying.

3: Share Action Plan

AB shared the action plan and the group talked through each of the five areas, focussing particularly on how to expand on the calendar of events across the school year. It was noted that the policies (both child and adult) would be up for review at the next meeting in the Spring term. Discussion around how any incidents of bullying are reported and resolved. Discussion around what the average parent already knew about anti-bullying strategy and procedure at Nutfield Church and how for most, it was an issue they did not research until they became directly affected. Therefore it was important for the Partnership to 'spread

the word'. AB made the point that it was not the job of the partnership to address parental concerns, rather to share information from the school and refer any questions/concerns to class teachers/SLT.

4: Spring Term planning

There was a discussion re. ideas for Spring term. Each half term the Anti-Bullying focus is linked to the school value. IN the Spring term these are Wisdom – which links to our 'TalkTime' Boxes and encouraging children to talk if they have any concerns. After half term, the value is Hope which we are linking to our Friendship Bench.

In addition, the big focus will be on Cyber Bullying and online safety. Each class will carry out a piece of computing work linked to staying safe online in an age-appropriate way. This work will be shared in the hall during Parents' Evenings in March.
