SATS

We are delighted to be welcoming Christian organisation Sparkfish back to run their annual THINK! Space for us. Sparkfish helps schools provide space in the curriculum for spiritual development. The team will convert our Southwark room into a special space for students to reflect, wonder, ponder and, if they wish, pray. THINK! draws on rich Christian traditions of reflection and prayer in an open and inclusive way. It is a place for quiet, but not for stillness. It is set up with activities to engage minds and hearts with questions there isn't usually time to ask: about life's origins and meaning, human values and relationships. Sparkfish will be running workshops on 5, 6 and 7th June for all the children and staff in the school.
