Governors' quiz

Pupil Parliament Elections

There has been great excitement this afternoon as the children have been voting for their representatives in our new Pupil Parliament. This half term, as a school and linked to our value, Community, we are learning more about the British Value of Democracy. Earlier in the week, Tandridge Council delivered polling booths and ballot boxes, ready for our Big Vote. Each class has nominated four candidates in advance. These children have made posters and have been busy 'campaigning' in their constituencies (classes) and during Phase Collective Worship to convince their class mates to vote for them! Today the school went to the polls to vote for the candidates they want to represent them at Pupil Parliament. The results will be announced on Tuesday 8th October (once all the votes have been counted and independently verified of course)! The Pupils' Parliament will be a School Council which this year, has a three strand foci – School Events – The Environment (focussing on attaining Green Flag status) and Well-Being.

School Uniform

Thank you to all who have been ordering your school uniform online. We still have some uniform stock on the premises e.g. fleeces/sweatshirts/cardigans/PE kit but we only have 24" and 34" polo shirts available. When ordering school uniform through Price & Buckland, there are two delivery options. Uniform posted direct to your home address at a charge of £3.95 for 1st class post (usually delivered within 5 working days) or £2.95 for 2nd class post. Alternatively, your uniform can be delivered directly to school free of charge. Orders will arrive on the 2nd and 4th Monday of every month, term time only as advised by Price & Buckland.
