

Love Project Autumn 2020



This Harvest, Nutfield Church school are continuing to support the Renewed Hope Trust by collecting items of food that can be used in their Drop-in Centre in Redhill and for their Food Bank.

Over the last two years, we have supported the Renewed Hope Trust as one of our six 'Love Projects' which run throughout the year. We have always been overwhelmed with your generous response and are therefore asking again for children in each year group to collect a specific item for this appeal. The aim is to help the children understand what someone with no home, who doesn't know where they will be sleeping from one night to another, needs to survive.

Please could children bring items specified for their particular year, ensuring that the items are well within the 'use by' date and of good quality. We would ask you to 'wipe over' any products you hand in and place them in the plastic boxes Fred leaves out in the mornings. There will be 2 large plastic boxes to collect the items, which will be placed on the grass behind the metal fencing. Please 'post' your items through the railings.

Collection dates will be from Monday September 28th until Friday 9th October.

Year R: Packets of biscuits or snacks for school lunches



Year 1: Tins of fruit, packets of custard or breakfast cereal



Year 2: Tins of vegetables or pasta hoops or ravioli or jars of pasta sauce (NO baked beans please)



Year 3: Tins of meat or jars of meal sauces e.g. curry, Thai, etc, or rice



Year 4: Kitchen and bathroom cleaners, detergents, washing up liquid, toiletries.



Years 5 & 6: Tea, coffee, fruit squash, salt & pepper, ketchup and sauces, cooking oil
