



Year 1 Homework Letter-Friday 1st October 2021

English

This week we have started a new book called 'The Naughty Bus'. So far we have used question words - who, what, why, where, when and how to ask questions about the bus being naughty. Also we learnt some interesting facts about buses by answering questions. Then the 'naughty bus' came in and messed up our classroom! So we wrote him a letter to tell him what he needed to do to make up for his naughtiness!

Reading books will be changed 3 times a week on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Please read with your child every evening if you are able for 10-15 minutes.

I have sent home again the Phase 3 tricky spellings (words that cannot be sounded out easily). Please continue to make sure that your child can read and spell all of these. Can they use those words in a written sentence?

Maths

This week we have practised subtracting numbers to 10 using knowledge of our number bonds, eg if $4 + 6 = 10$ then $10 - 6 = 4$. First we subtracted single digit numbers followed by a one digit from a two digit number. Also this week, we are learning how to write numbers in words to 10 and some to 20.

Homework

Please continue to practise with your child their number bonds to 10 e.g $10+0=10, 9+1=10$ etc so that they can recall them very quickly.
