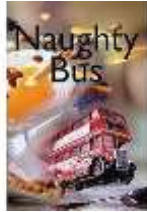




Year 1 Homework Letter-Friday 8th October 2021

English

This week we have learnt 'The Naughty Bus' story with actions. There had been reports that the naughty bus had been messing around so we went on an investigative hunt to see what we could find. Next week we will use this to write 'The Further Adventures of Naughty Bus'.



Homework

The following day we used cubes and other non-standard units e.g hand span to measure various items.

On Purple Mash, I have set some measure homework on 'longer and shorter' and 'shorter and tallest'. Some children may also like to have a go at the measuring in cm which can be found under Home/ Mathematics /Measure/5-7.
