English

This week we are writing the sequel to 'Naughty Bus' - 'The Further Adventures of Naughty Bus'. We have used pictures from Naughty Bus' adventure last week to plan out our story. We have improved our stories by adding detail of how the character is feeling and writing our own ending. We are becoming more confident at using adjectives.

Homework

We identified their properties e.g number of corners and sides and whether the sides were straight or curved. We then sorted shapes according to these properties and made pictures and patterns with 2D shapes. It was reinforced that the size, orientation and colour doesn't change the name of a shape.

Try and spot 2D shapes in your house and when you are outside. How many different ones can you spot? Can you describe them using the vocabulary above? Can you take a photo of them to record your findings? Please continue to practice as well saying and writing the numbers to 50.
