English:

The children have loved reading more of the 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl. They have been using a thesaurus to find synonyms for words to make their writing more exciting. We have also been focusing on inferring information from a text regarding a character's emotions. They have all worked hard to create a diary entry from Sophie's perspective while she was being carried in the BFG's pocket.

Maths:

This week, we have started learning about time. As a class we have looked at the following:

- ◆ Number of days in the months in the year.
- ◆ Calculating the number of days in a number of days.
- ◆ Telling the time—in intervals of 1 and 5—on a clock.
- ◆ Learning to recognise AM and PM.
