### English:

The children have loved reading more of the 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl. They began the week by creating their own plans to help Sophie and the BFG to defeat the giants by using fronted adverbials to order the steps of their plan. They then began to plan their own story by creating their own human and giant characters.

### Maths:

This week, we have started learning about measurement. As a class we have looked at the following:

- To use cm and mm when using ruler to measure and draw lines/objects.
- To compare cm and metres and to convert between the two.
- To compare cm and millimetres and to convert between the two.
