English

As usual there will be a test on Friday morning. During Maths next week, we are going to be covering 'Length and Perimeter'. Looking ahead to this, I would like the children to tackle the sheets in their homework book. Please remember, the perimeter is the total length of the sides of a two-dimensional shape.

Maths

This week we have been looking at time. The children have worked incredibly hard. During the course of the week we have been talking about the concept of time. Understanding what unit of time to use to measure different events. We also spent time, converting between 12-hour clocks and 24-hour clocks before tackling some time word problems.

During Art this term we have been learning all about Picasso. During our lessons we have been drawing and painting our own 'Picassos'. As you can see from the evidence below, there are some really good ones!
